Following the meeting of the Long Man Parish Council please find below their response:

Long Man Parish Council opposes both claimed routes in Fokington put forward by the Ramblers Association. Our understanding is that there has been no path on either routes since before the 1870s. There are old houses and gardens along the claimed routes which would be severely adversely impacted by the claimed routes.

Neither route connects up to an existing footpath and there is a quiet country lane with wide verges linking the 2 endpoints of the claimed routes. The proposals put forward by the Ramblers Association completely ignores the benefits of this lane for walkers, and indeed any developments since the 1870's.

We would be grateful if you could let us know what the next stage of the process is and when the final decision is likely to be made and by whom the final decision is made by.
