THE EAST SUSSEX (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS HASTINGS 425a, 425b, 425c, 425d, 425e) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

As instructed by the Secretary of State, East Sussex County Council made the above-named Order on 11 June 2021.

During the objection period of Friday 18 June 2021 to 2 August 2021 one valid objection was received, which as it was not withdrawn meant that the Order is now opposed.

The Council has referred the case to the Planning Inspectorate who intend to inform us within 9 weeks how they wish to proceed.
