**Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 – Section 53
Claimed Public Right of Way at Guestling: Claimed Footpath from Guestling 10b to 9.**

The County Council has received an application under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to amend the Definitive Map and Statement for the area.

Please note that the County Council has a duty to investigate such claims. Part of the investigation is to consult with all relevant local councils and user groups. The County Council will act impartially and take evidence from opposing sides. Historical research will be carried out and, once the evidence is before us a report will be presented to the Delegated Officer for a decision.
