The above Order has now been made by the County Council. The Explanatory Statement East Sussex County Council made the above named Order on 11 March 2022.

During the objection period of Friday 18 March 2022 to Monday 9 May 2022 two valid objections were received, which as they were not withdrawn meant that the Order is now opposed.

The Council has referred the case to the Planning Inspectorate on 27 May 2022 who intend to inform us within 9 weeks of 30 May 2022 how they wish to proceed but sometimes this can be delayed.

A copy of the Order, Order plan, Explanatory Statement, Public Notice and the Objection are available for public inspection at Reception, County Hall, East Sussex County Council, St. Anne's Crescent, Lewes East Sussex BN7 1UE, 9am to 5pm Monday to Thursday and 9am-4.30pm on Fridays.
