Subject: RWO/193A Bridleway at the Old Racecourse Lewes

Dear ESCC,

I am contacting you about the bridleway at the Old Racecourse Lewes ref RW0/193A

I note that the route B, (and DC) to E is not included in the order.

The route B, (and DC) to E is under threat and I am asking you to include it in the order for the following reasons:

The route B to C can be chaotic and dangerous with livestock, construction traffic, agricultural machinery, local residents, cyclists and walkers channelled down it;

There is a cafe development in the field to the South of route B, (and DC) to E which might, in due course, encroach on the path;

I understand that more developments on the Racecourse land, such as camping, further accommodation and festival events, could be in the pipe-line.

Given the likelihood of development I consider it most important that the route B to E is protected because it provides safe and direct access to the Black Cap bridleway without going on to the private road or through the Racecourse stables and housing.
